

NOTE: Family fees: The spouse who accompanies his wife or her husband to College is not charged for college fee only registration, Exam and graduation fees paid.

OBTAINING THE QUALIFICATION

1.SUBMISSION OF ASSIGNMENTS

Research papers and assignments must be submitted according to the prescribed format and referencing techniques according to the WBCI method.

A lecturer may

refuse to accept work or penalise the Student's work if it is not done to the utmost accuracy, care and pride.

2. DEADLINES

Deadlines as prescribed in the module syllabus must be adhered to. A penalty of 5% may be subtracted from the final mark for each day overdue. The final due date for any submissions must be observed.

3.EXTENSION

Students who cannot complete their submission by the due date, owing to circumstances beyond their control may petition the Vice-Principal of Academics for an extension of time. An "Extension of Submissions" form must be completed and given to the Registrar with payment of a charge.

The Vice Principal for Academ<mark>ics, and the lecturer may grant an extension and set penalties or additional work.</mark>

4.EXAMINATION PROCEDURES

Examination procedures are designed and enforced because the college would like the Student to value his/her education.
